Postdoctoral opening in Condensed Matter Theory

A postdoctoral position is available in condensed matter theory in the Physics Department at the College of William and Mary (W&M). The focus of the research is the study of the electronic behavior of novel two-dimensional systems and heterostructures. The candidate will work primarily with Professor Enrico Rossi. The initial appointment will be made for one year renewable for one more year upon mutual agreement and availability of funds.

Candidates must have a Ph.D. in theoretical condensed matter physics or closely related subfield. Experience in the field of low-dimensional electronic systems is highly desirable.

To apply the candidates should submit a CV, cover letter, a short (1-2 pages) research statement, and the names of at least three references via the W&M recruitment site (jobs.wm.edu) at the link https://jobs.wm.edu/postings/16018. The references will then be contacted by us with instructions for submitting a letter of reference. To receive full consideration applications should be received by January 31, 2014, but the search will continue until the position is filled.
